**Autumn produce is in full swing at Mountain View Fruit Sales**

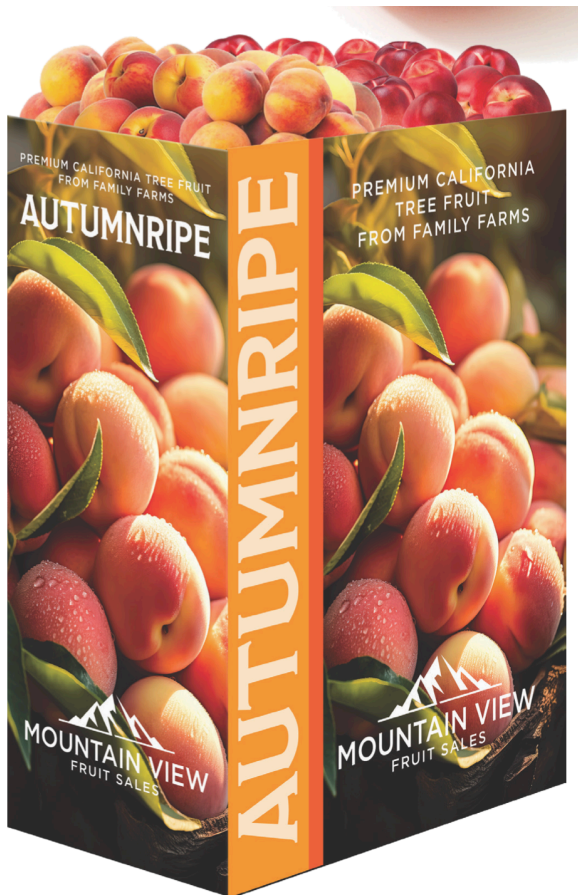
